"The Latest Cutting Edge Strategies on Tax Reduction, Estate Planning and Lawsuit Protection for Dentists"



Course Description: This course will teach attendees how to maintain the focus of their dental practice on improved patient care rather than malpractice defense, how to structure practices for malpractice protection and prevention, and how to reduce malpractice insurance costs.

- Structure practices (C-corps, S-corps, LLPs, LLCs, etc.)
- Create an ironclad division between professional practice and personal assets.
- Protect the practice, assets, and property in the event of a judgment in excess of liability insurance or exclusion in the policy.
- Set up a new practice or make changes in an existing practice to minimize liability and learn the best way to structure a practice if two or more dentists are practicing together.
- Use fringe benefits uniquely available to dentists under Sections 79, 105 and 162 of the IRS Code. (Even your swimming pool and sauna are now tax deductible.)

"Mastering Adhesive Dentistry - Tools, Materials, and Techniques for Routine Excellence"

Course Description: Since the late 1970s, a revolution has taken place with dental materials fueled by advances in adhesive products that have dramatically changed the practice of dentistry. Preparation designs are no longer driven by the need for mechanical retention and it is no longer necessary to fuse porcelain to metal for strength considerations. The effects of these innovations have resulted in what we now call minimal invasive dentistry. Adhesive materials now strengthen and mimic teeth in appearance in such a way that it is now possible to more easily restore a tooth to its original strength and appearance.



Course Objectives: Upon completion of this course, attendees will know how to outline products and protocols to simplify adhesive techniques making them more predictable and profitable. After a demonstration using both direct and indirect applications, participants should have confidence to select products and use techniques that will enhance their practice with predictable and profitable esthetic restorations. Attendees should also have a better understanding of how to develop solutions to problems such as margin white lines, leakage and tooth sensitivity.

Cancellation of individual units with the group block must be done at least 30 days prior to the scheduled arrival dates to receive a refund of deposit. Any cancellations made within 30 days of the scheduled arrival date will forfeit the entire deposit on the unit.
