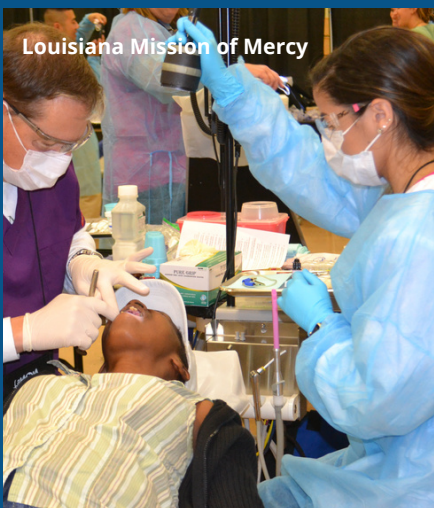

You will stay updated on modern dentistry through the *LDA Journal*, e-bytes, text alerts, our social media, and more.



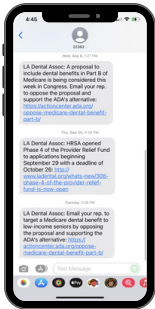

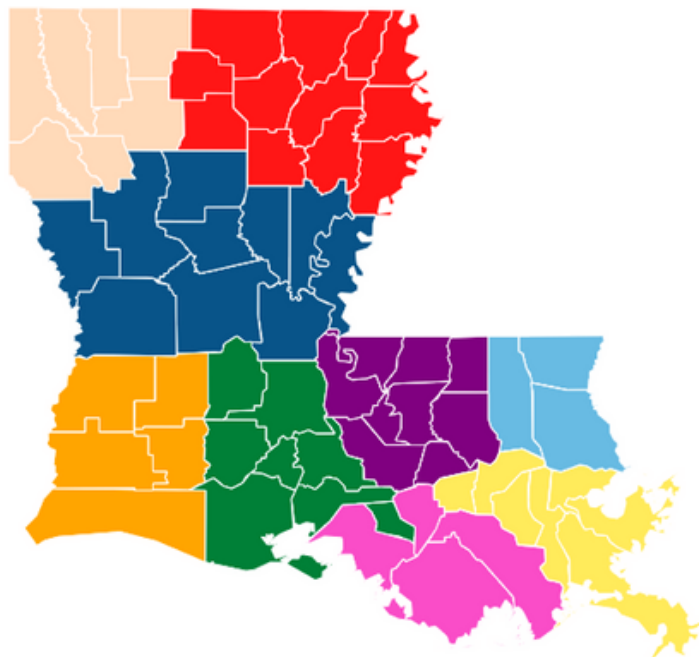


LDA Foundation Fishing Rodeo
